

The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.

ORDER

WHEREAS the appeal of Shabari Balika Mahavidyalaya, Ghazipur, Uttar Pradesh dated 01/12/2009 is against the Order No. FNRC/ACD/1/1-7/UP-1/21/2009/11063 dated 06/10/2009 of the Northern Regional Committee, refusing recognition for conducting BTC course on the grounds "Deficiencies communicated in the deficiency letter issued by the office are not removed within stipulated period".

AND WHEREAS the Correspondent, Shabari Balika Mahavidyalaya (hereinafter referred to as the appellant), preferred an appeal dated 01/12/2009 to the National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as the Council) under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the said Order.

AND WHEREAS Shri. Paras Nath Rai, Manager, Shabari Balika Mahavidyalaya, Ghazipur, Uttar Pradesh presented the case of the appellant institution on 15.03.2010 in the appeal and during personal presentation it was submitted that the institution fulfilled all the requirements as per the NCTE norms and that the delay in submission of compliance of deficiencies was due to late receipt of communication from NRC, Jaipur.

AND WHEREAS the Council noted that NRC vide its letter dt. 14.03.06, communicated deficiencies with regard to internet facility, website, reserve fund and affidavit on Rs. 100/- stamp paper. The Council perused the documents submitted by the appellant, in proof of removal of the deficiencies and noted that the institution had internet facility, launched its website and also created reserve fund of Rs. 3 lakhs. In view of the above the Council came to the conclusion that there was adequate justification for accepting the appeal and remanding the case to NRC for issuance of letter of intent prior to recognition under Clause 7(9) of NCTE regulations.

AND WHEREAS after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit, VT Report and after hearing oral arguments advanced during the presentation, the Council came to the conclusion that there was adequate ground to accept the appeal, set aside NRC's order dated 06-10-2009 and remand the case to the NRC for issuing Letter of intent prior to recognition. Accordingly, the appeal was accepted and the case remanded to the NRC for issuing Letter of intent prior to grant of recognition under 7(9) of Regulations.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council hereby remands back the case of Shabari Balika Mahavidyalaya, Ghazipur, Uttar Pradesh to the NRC, NCTE, for necessary action as indicated above.
